- 1. The proposed 2019 operating budget increased \$201 (or 0.1%) when compared to the 2018 budget. The 2019 budget includes a decrease of \$3,200 (or 28.8%) for office space rent when compared to the 2018 budget. This decrease is based on the projected amount due under the renewal option of the lease agreement that the Agency entered into on June 1, 2016.
- 2. The proposed 2019 Revenues are unchanged when compared to the 2018 budget.
- 3. The state of the local/regional economy is projected to have no impact on the proposed 2019 budget when compared to the 2018 budget.
- 4. Unrestricted Net Position in the amount of \$121,634 is utilized to balance the proposed 2019 budget.
