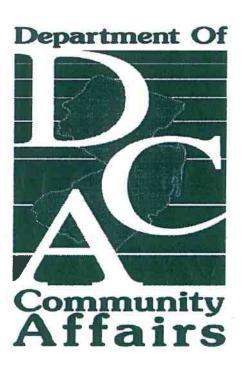

- 1. (a) The proposed 2020 operating budget increased \$62,485 (or 16%) when compared to the 2019 budget.
 - (b) The 2020 budget includes an increase of \$34,000 (or 432%) for office space rent when compared to the 2019 budget. This increase is based on a combination of utilities costs and a scheduled under the lease agreement that the Agency entered into on August 17, 2018.
 - (c) The 2020 budget includes a Building Maintenance appropriation in the amount of \$25,000 for certain maintenance activities which were not budgeted for in prior years.
- 2. The proposed 2020 Revenues in the amount of \$293,692 represent an increase of \$30,000 (or 11.4%) when compared to the 2019 budget. This is due to an anticipated increase in redeveloper fees.
- 3. The state of the local/regional economy is projected to have no impact on the proposed 2020 budget when compared to the 2019 budget.
- 4. Unrestricted Net Position in the amount of \$154,119 is utilized to balance the proposed 2020 budget.
- 5. The South Amboy Redevelopment Agency has appropriated \$46,697 in its 2020 budget for administrative services to be provided by the City of South Amboy as a shared service. An additional \$100,000 has been appropriated in the 2020 budget for professional services to be provided by the City of South Amboy as a shared service.
- 6. There is no deficit in the proposed 2020 budget.

Compensation includes payments and other benefits provided to both employees and independent contractors in exchange for services.
- Reportable compensation: (<u>Use the Most Recent W-2 available 2017 or 2018</u>. The aggregate compensation that is reported (or is required to be reported) on Form W-2, box 1 or 5, whichever amount is greater, and/or Form 1099-MISC, box 7, for the most recent calendar year ended 60 days before the start of the proposed budget year. For example, for fiscal years ending December 31, 2019, the <u>most recent W-2</u> and 1099 should be used 2018 or 2017 (60 days prior to start of budget year is November 1, 2018, with 2017 being the most recent calendar year ended), and for fiscal years ending June 30, 2019, the calendar year 2018 W-2 and 1099 should be used (60 days prior to start of budget year is May 1, 2018, with 2018 being the most recent calendar year ended).
- Other Public Entity: Any municipality, county, local authority, fire district, or other government unit, regardless of whether it is related in any way to the Authority either by function or by physical location.
