**RESOLUTION NO 22-200**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PERSON TO PERSON  
TRANSFER OF PLENARY RETAIL DISTRIBUTION  
LICENSE NO. 1220-44-036-006**

**WHEREAS**, an application has been filed by South Amboy Wine & Liquor Inc., for the person-to-person transfer of Plenary Retail Distribution License No. 1220-44-036-006, for a Plenary Retail Distribution license with a mailing address of Arjun Inc. dba Main Liquors, 533 Main Street, South Amboy; and

**WHEREAS**, the submitted application form is complete in all respects, the transfer fees have been paid and the license has been properly renewed for the current license term;
