#### **Interpretations and Addenda**

Respondents are expected to examine the RFQ/RFP with care and observe all its requirements. All questions about the meaning or intent of this RFQ/RFP, all interpretations and clarifications considered necessary by the Owner's representative in response to such comments and questions will be issued by Addenda posted on the City of South Amboy's website, <a href="www.southamboynj.gov">www.southamboynj.gov</a> Only comments and questions responded to by formal written Addenda will be binding. Oral interpretations, statements or clarifications are without legal effect.

#### **Cost Liability and Additional Costs**

The Owner assumes no responsibility or liability for costs incurred by the Respondents prior to the issuance of an agreement. The liability of the Owner shall be limited to the terms and conditions of the Contract.

Respondents will assume responsibility for all costs not stated in their proposals. All unit rates either stated in the proposal or used as a basis for its pricing are required to be all-inclusive. Additional charges, unless incurred for additional work performed by request of the Owner, are not to be billed and will not be paid.

#### **Local State and Federal Requirements**

The Respondent must comply with all Local and State requirements.

The Respondent shall complete projects that may include federal funding from, but not exclusive to, the US Economic Development Administration (US EDA), National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF), and Housing and Economic Development (HUD). #### **Compliance with Laws**

The Respondent shall complete and submit the form of statement that is included in this RFQ/RFP.

The Respondent is obligated to comply with the Act and hold the Owner harmless.

#### **Insurance and Indemnification**

If it becomes necessary for the successful Respondent, either as principal or by agent or employee, to enter upon the premises or property of the Owner, the successful Respondent hereby covenants and agrees to take use, provide and make all proper, necessary and sufficient precautions, safeguards, and protection against the occurrence of happenings of any accident, injuries damages or hurt to person or property during the course of the work herein covered and his/her sole responsibility.

The successful Respondent further covenants and agrees to indemnify and save harmless the owner from the payment of all sums of money or any other consideration(s) by reason of any, or all, such accidents, injuries, damages or hurt that may happen or occur upon or about such work and all fines, penalties incurred for or by reason of the violation of any owner regulation, ordinance or the laws of the State, or the United States while said work is in progress.

The successful Respondent shall maintain sufficient insurance to protect against all claims under Workers Compensation, General Liability and Automobile and shall be subject to approval for adequacy of protection and certificates of such insurance shall be provided.

#### **Multiple Proposals Not Accepted**

More than one proposal from an individual, a firm or partnership, a corporation or association under the same or different names for the same service shall not be considered.

#### **Failure to Enter Contract**

Should the Respondent, to whom the contract is awarded, fail to enter into a contract within ten (10) days, Sundays and holidays excepted, the Owner may then, at its option, accept the proposal of another Respondent.

#### **Commencement of Work**

The successful Respondent agrees to commence work after the date of award by the Owner and upon notice from the Using Department.

#### **Termination of Contract**

If, through any cause, the successful Respondent shall fail to fulfill in a timely and proper manner obligations under the contract or if the successful Respondent violates any requirement of the Contract, the Owner shall thereupon have the right to terminate the Contract by giving written notice to the contractor of such termination at least thirty (30) days prior to the proposed effective date of the termination. Such termination shall relieve the Owner of any obligation for the balances to the successful Respondent of any sum or sums set forth in the Contract.

#### **Payment**

Invoices shall specify, in detail, the period for which payment is claimed, the services performed during the prescribed period, and the amount claimed for services performed.

The Owner may withhold all or partial payments on account of subsequently discovered evidence including but not limited to the following:

Deliverables not complying with the project specification; Claims filed or responsible evidence indicating probability of filing claims; A reasonable doubt that the Contract can be completed for the balance then unpaid.

When the above grounds are removed, payment shall be made for amounts withheld because of them.

#### Ownership of Material

The Owner shall retain all its rights and interest in any and all documents and property both hard copy and digital furnished by the Owner to the successful Respondent for the purpose of assisting the successful Respondent in the performance of this Contract. All such items shall be returned immediately to the Owner at the expiration or termination of the Contract or completion of any related services pursuant thereto, whichever comes first. None of the documents and/or property shall, without the written consent of the Owner, be disclosed to others or used by the successful Respondent or permitted by the successful

Respondent to be used by their parties at any time except in the performance of the resulting Contract.

Ownership of all data, materials and documentation originated and prepared for the Owner pursuant to this Contract shall belong exclusively to the Owner. All data, reports, computerized information, programs and materials shall be delivered to and become the property of the Owner upon completion of the project. The successful Respondent shall not have the right to use, sell or disclose the total of the interim or final work products, or make available to third parties, without the prior written consent of the Owner.

#### **Grant Writer**

The City of South Amboy desires to hire a consultant to assist in the application, processing, reporting, auditing and exercising federal, state and local grants. The Professional Qualifications for the Grant Writer shall include but may not be limited to the following:

- 1. Must hold a current and valid Business Registration Certificate in the State of New Jersey and have a favorable record with the State of New Jersey;
- 2. A minimum of at least five years' experience in the proposer's profession, including exposure to issues likely to be of assistance in serving as Grant Writer;
- 3. The ability of the assigned Grant Writer to attend meetings of the City.
- 4. Must list past and present public entities represented as Grant Writer.
- 5. Other factors if demonstrated to be in the best interest of the City;

#### **Specific Criteria**

The duties of the Professional Grant Writer shall include securing outside and/or third party funding sources for the City's projects with appropriate sources approved by the City and to provide assistance to the City in grant funding related matters as needed or assigned. Please provide the following information;

- 1. Describe how your firm reviews all plan documents for compliance with applicable laws and contracted agreements.
- 2. Provide and describe a fee schedule and structure, including hourly rates, percentage of administrative grant costs, and/or contingency fee schedule etc.

#### **Payment**

Payment will be made monthly on presentation of Owner's voucher duly signed and executed. Invoices shall be submitted by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month for the services provided in the previous calendar month.

Term of the Contract – 12 month term (2026)

#### **Notice of Award**

The successful Respondent will be notified of the award of Contract upon a favorable decision by the appointing authority.
